Uniform

Our school uniform has a red theme. We prefer children to wear uniform containing the school logo which can be purchased from our selected suppliers (value for money checks have been completed prior to engagement with suppliers). Red and white check dress Closed toe sandals Sunhat Sunglasses	Long hair must be tied back (please provide a band) Watches and earrings must be removed (see below). Footwear for PE Barefoot working is recommended for activities such as gymnastics and dance. Training shoes must not be worn for gymnastics or dance, as their hard plastic soles are inflexible and give poor grip. Appropriate footwear must be worn for outside PE.

Jewellery

Children should not wear bracelets or necklaces whilst in school or ornate head wear.

Small stud earrings may be worn. Where ears have been pierced earrings must be removed on PE days. If this is not possible due to recent piercing, children must independently apply tape to their own ears. Adults in school will NOT remove or tape earrings. School does not accept any liability for loss or damages that occur.

A small watch may be worn. Watches that are also telephones are not allowed. Watches must be removed for PE and school does not accept any liability for loss or damages that occur.

Additional Requirements

Nail varnish and tattoos are not permitted in school.

Long hair should be pushed off of children's faces so that they can see and eat safely.
