Rationale

- To develop a school identity and reflect our school ethos of CARE.
- To engender a sense of community and belonging.
- To enable children to feel equal to their peers.
- To enable children to move freely and take part in all activities.
- To reduce anxiety surrounding the issues of clothing.

Uniform

Our uniform consists of:

- Red fleece (preferred), cardigan or jumper (logo option preferred and available via supplier/ PTA preloved stock)
- White short sleeved polo shirt (logo option preferred and available via supplier/ PTA preloved stock)
- Plain black **UNBRANDED*** activewear tracksuit trousers, shorts, leggings or skort**
- Plain white or grey socks **UNBRANDED**
- Comfortable trainers that are either mainly white or mainly black
- Weatherproof coat
- Sunglasses/ sun hat for warm weather
- Red and white check summer dress for warm weather

**We appreciate that some children may prefer to wear a more formal uniform.

In this case, plain grey trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore dress should be worn in place of the active wear except on PE days, when activewear must be worn.

Jewellery

Children should not wear **bracelets or necklaces** whilst in school or ornate head wear.

Small stud earrings may be worn. Where ears have been pierced earrings must be removed on PE days. If this is not possible due to recent piercing, children must independently apply tape to their own ears. Adults in school will NOT remove or tape earrings. School does not accept any liability for loss or damages that occur.

A small watch may be worn. Watches that are also telephones and/ or that connect to the internet and/ or that can be used to play games **are not allowed**. Watches must be removed for PE and school does not accept any liability for loss or damages that occur.

Additional Requirements

Nail varnish and tattoos are not permitted in school.

Long hair should be pushed off of children's faces so that they can see and eat safely. It must be tied back for PE.

Equality and Diversity

Greatham Primary School values and recognises the diversity of cultures, religions and disabilities and will take a sensitive approach when this affects dress requirements whilst taking into account health and safety regulations. A discussion with the Headteacher is required in these circumstances.
