### Key strengths highlighted include:

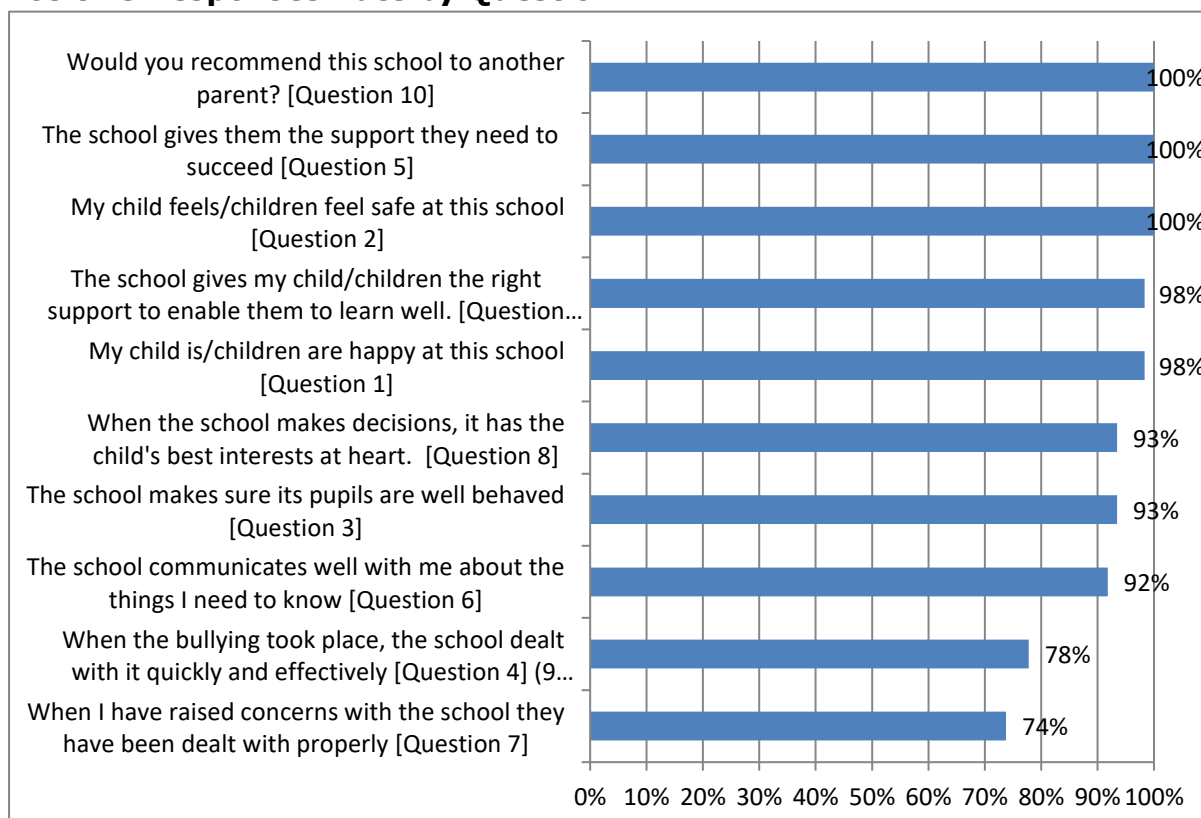
- Pupil safety

The question with the highest negative response rate was:

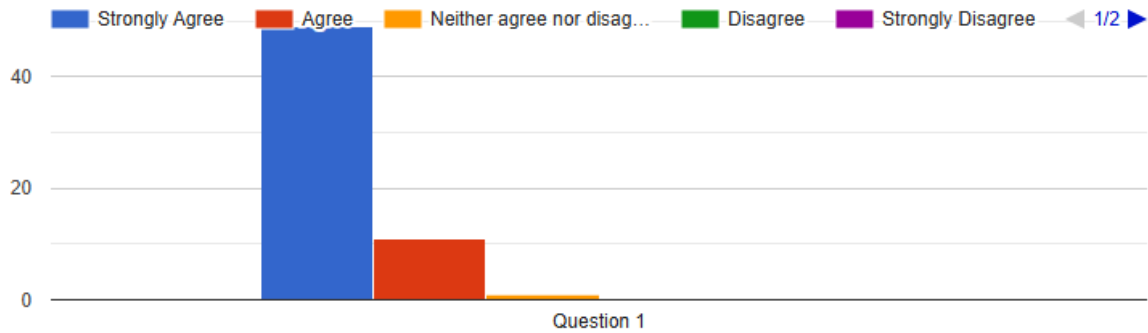
“Q6: The school communicates well with me.”

Additionally, the question about handling concerns had the largest mix of neutral or unsure responses, suggesting there may be opportunities to improve communication and follow-up when concerns are raised.

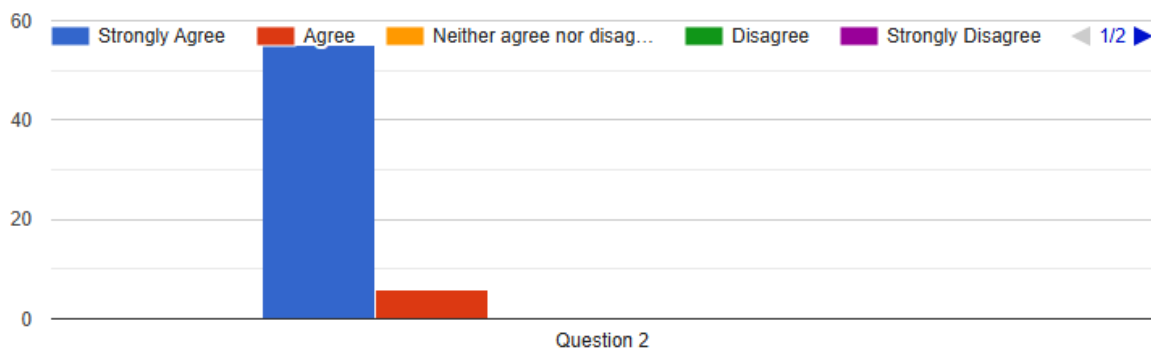

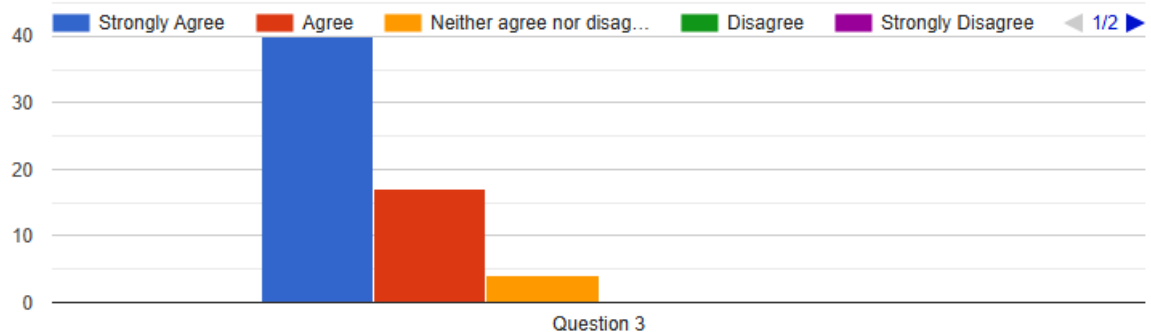
My child feels/children feel safe at this school

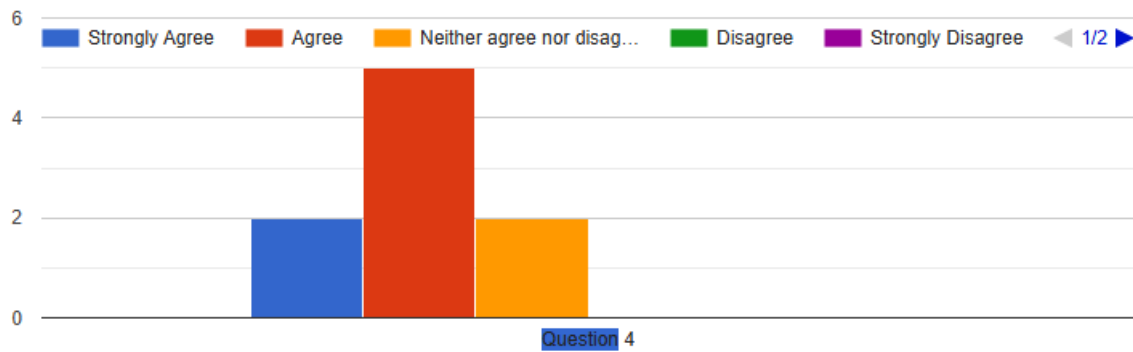
The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved

When the bullying took place, the school dealt with it quickly and effectively

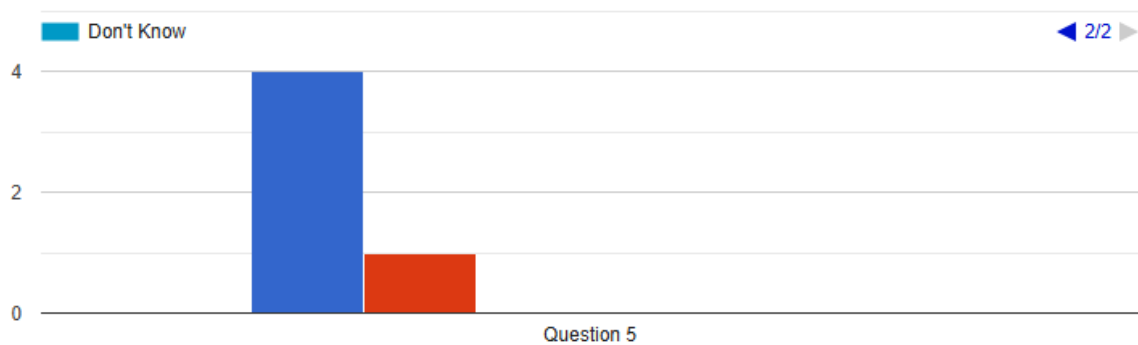

The school gives them the support they need to succeed

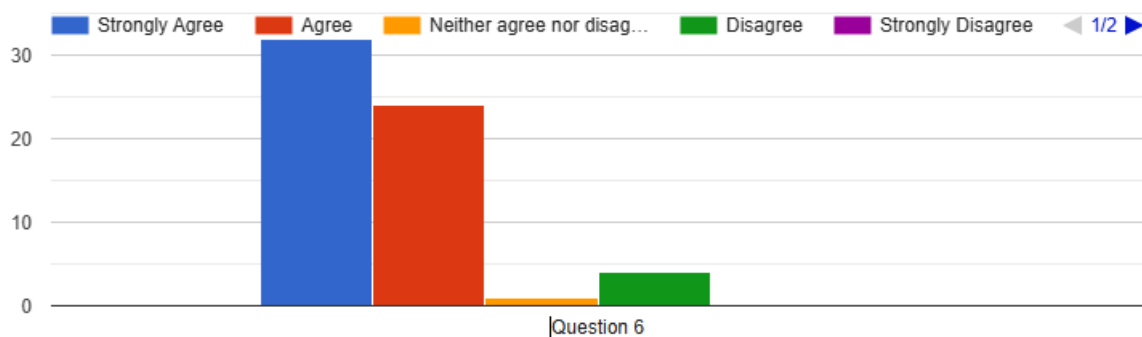

Above graph was for 5 responses – SEND children

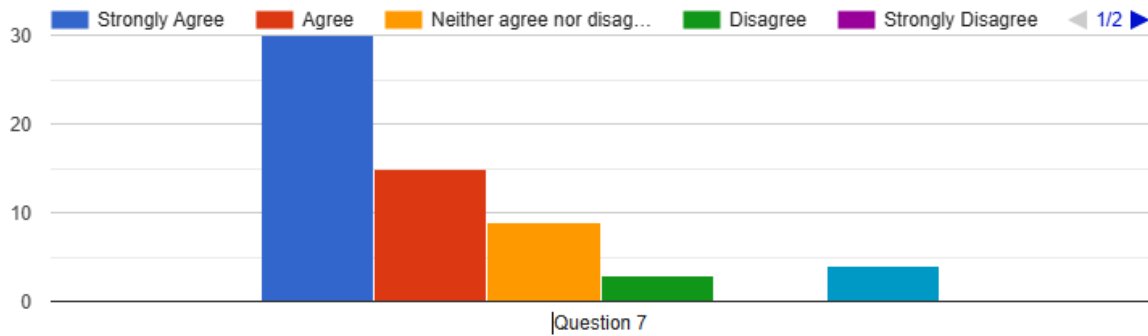
The school communicates well with me about the things I need to know

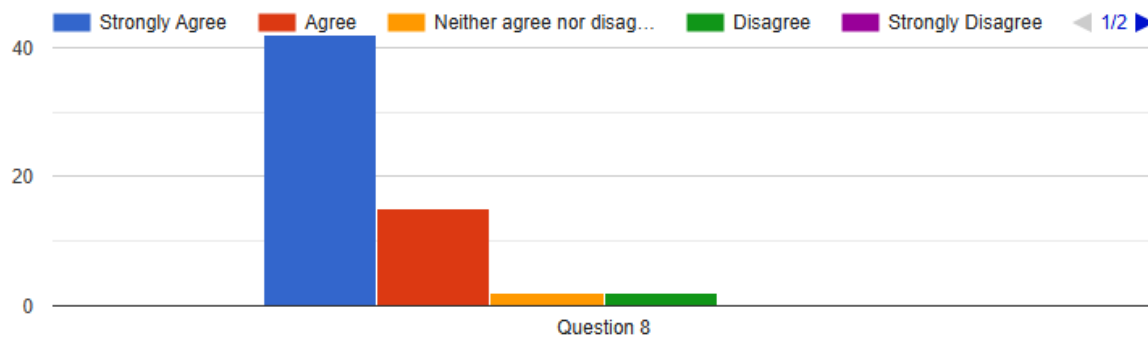

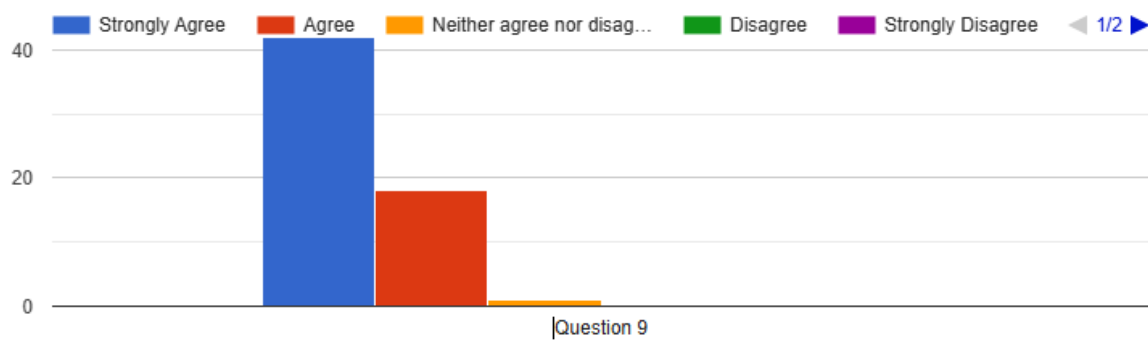
When the school makes decisions, it has the child's best interests at heart.
